Covenant Enforcement Update: At the February 13, 2024, meeting the Board voted to move forward with enforcement of the Amendment Covenants of Restrictions, June 12, 2001, Item 6, No Livestock shall be kept upon any lot; specifically, the donkey located on Danielle Maple's property at 7213 Mound Ridge Rd. An Executive Session was held on April 26, 2024, UPID Board Members, James Slaymaker Jo Ann Zahner & Sarah Dahl met to discuss progress.
