Hello University Park Board,

The following will serve as the final update for 2025 as we head into the holiday season. Things are progressing smoothly and grant disbursements have started coming in. We have received several disbursements to date, and expect another disbursement soon which will cover most of the remaining costs for the project. Once these disbursements are processed, we will be able to refund the loan we are currently operating with.

For transparency, it is worth noting that some of the costs for the project will not be covered under the grant programs. As we would expect, there are stringent requirements on these agreements which only cover certain aspects of the project and require certain steps be followed prior to issuing work. Several contracts have been retroactively amended to qualify for grant funding, but there are some other costs that will likely need to be covered through "cash on hand" or included in a final assessment. We will discuss options for covering these costs as we approach the project's completion.

The lagoon project was let for construction in early December with a bid opening date of January 15th, 2026. We hope to start construction within 30-60 days after signing contracts, so construction will likely begin in late February or March. I will try to send another update after contracts are signed to inform everyone of what to expect with cost and construction timelines.
